Please find enclosed the 2022 Annual Report for Oregon-Idaho Utilities, Inc. (OIU). Consistent with our practice in prior years, we have prepared the Idaho report by attaching the title page and certification form to the information set forth in our Oregon Form O report for the same period.

The data set forth in this report depicts OIU's combined Oregon and Idaho operations. Under the rules of the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA), OIU's combined Oregon and Idaho operations are defined as a single study area, and the company therefore prepares a single cost study, using one set of accounting records, to represent its combined operations in these two states. As such, any attempt to report Idaho specific operating results is not feasible. As a general rule though, the company has historically reported the Idaho-specific portion of the total study area data shown in this report as approximately 10% of the total company.
