Industrial Customers of Idaho Power (“ICIP”) petitioned to intervene in this case on February 12, 2018, pursuant to Rules of Procedure 71 through 75 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075. With its Petition, ICIP filed a Notice of Waiver of Service that waived service of all process not relevant to Idaho Power Company.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

We find that no party timely opposed this Petition to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by this party would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and should be granted.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by Industrial Customers of Idaho Power is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties in this proceeding serve all papers hereafter filed in this matter on all parties of record. As an exception to this general service requirement, parties need only serve the ICIP with pleadings addressing the impact of the federal tax code revisions on Idaho Power’s electric rates and cost of service. 
