On July 3, 2017, Rocky Mountain Power applied for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct or acquire four new wind projects with a total combined capacity of 860 megawatts. The Company also requested CPCNs for several transmission facilities associated with the Company's Gateway West transmission project. The Company asserted that the project will provide significant economic benefits for the Company's customers, and that the projects are time-limited due to federal production tax credits.
