# THE IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION'S ELIGIBIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER (ETC) ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

#### FILING DEADLINES

▶ By July 1, 2017: All ETCs requesting federal high-cost or low-income support from the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) must file with the IPUC, FCC Form 481 (47 C.F.R. §§ 54.313 & 54.422) along with a Signed Affidavit (see note). IPUC Filing methods:

➤ By September 1, 2017: All other ETCs who do not receive federal high cost funds must file Form 481 and affidavit (minus item 5) with the Commission Secretary. This satisfied the PUC annual report requirement for ETCs. See Order No. 29841.

#### Notes:

- When filing Form 481 with the FCC, clearly reference WC Docket Nos. 10-90 and 11-42 (as appropriate).
- The FCC does not require the signed affidavit.
- ➤ **Before October 1, 2017:** The PUC Staff will submit the *Annual Use Certification* Letter (47 C.F.R. § 54.314) to USAC and the FCC on behalf of Idaho ETCs who receive federal high-cost support.

The Idaho Public Utilities Commission Order No. 29841 requires that Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETC) certify that it is compliant with applicable service quality standards and consumer protection rules; and ETCs must demonstrate the ability to remain functional in emergencies. In addition, the Commission must file an annual certification with the USAC and the FCC that all federal high-cost support provided to ETCs within the State of Idaho will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended. Accordingly, the undersigned states and verifies under oath the following:
