It is also the court's responsibility to determine the validity of the exculpatory clause.

Carrier will give at least 10 days notice to customers and the Idaho PUC before increasing rates or other changes. The notice to customers will be either individual notices or a public notice in the newspapers in Carrier's Idaho service areas.
