

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

**March 15, 2022 – 1:30 P.M.**

In attendance was Commissioner Eric Anderson and Commissioner John Chatburn. Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. participated via telephone. Commissioner Anderson called the meeting to order.
