

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

**July 12, 2022 – 1:30 P.M.**

In attendance was Commissioner Eric Anderson, Commissioner John Chatburn and Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. Commissioner Anderson called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING** on July 5, 2022. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.

The next order of business was **CONSENT AGENDA:**
