

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

**June 6, 2023 – 1:30 P.M.**

In attendance was Commissioner Eric Anderson and Commissioner Edward Lodge. Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. participated via telephone. Commissioner Anderson called the meeting to order.
