

IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

September 14, 2023 – 1:30 P.M.

In attendance was Commissioner Eric Anderson and Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. Commissioner Edward Lodge participated via telephone. Commissioner Anderson called the meeting to order.
