

IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

January 20th, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

In attendance was Commissioner Edward Lodge, Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner Lodge called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was the **ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDED AGENDA** for January 20th, 2026.
