

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

**February 3rd, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.**

In attendance was Commissioner Edward Lodge, Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner Lodge called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was the **ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDED AGENDA** for February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026.

Commissioner Lodge made a motion, under Idaho Code § 74-204, to amend the agenda, moving Action Items No. 5 from the CONSENT AGENDA to MATTERS IN PROGRESS, Action Item No. 5: Erika Melanson's February 3, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Intermountain Gas Company's 2025 Integrated Resource Plan; Case No. INT-G-25-08. A vote was taken on the motion and it carried unanimously.

The next order of business was the **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING** on January 27th, 2026. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.

Commissioner Lodge made a motion to approve Staff's recommendations for Items 2 through 4 and 6 through 9 under the Consent Agenda. A vote was taken on the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The next order of business was **MATTERS IN PROGRESS:**

**5. Action Item: Erika Melanson's February 3, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Intermountain Gas Company's 2025 Integrated Resource Plan; Case No. INT-G-25-08.**

Commissioner Hardie noted that staff proposed issuing a notice of filing and a notice of modified procedure for the case. As a procedural safeguard Commissioner Hardie suggested adding an intervention deadline, noting that prior Intermountain IRP cases included one.

Ms. Melanson stated staff had no objection to adding an intervention deadline at this time.

Commissioner Hardie made a motion for the commission to issue a notice of filing, notice of intervention establishing a 21-day intervention deadline for interested parties and a notice of modified procedure establishing a May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, public comment deadline and a June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, reply comment deadline. A vote was taken on the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The last order of business was **FULLY SUBMITTED MATTERS:**

**10. Deliberation re: Investigation into Rivervine Water & Sewer, LLC, Owner of a Water Supply and Distribution System; Case No. RWS-W-25-01 [Jeffrey R. Loll, Attorney].**

**11. Deliberation re: In the Matter of Idaho Power Company's 2025 Integrated Resource Plan; Case No. IPC-E-25-23 [Jeffrey R. Loll, Attorney].**

Commissioner Lodge stated that Items 10 and 11 under Fully Submitted Matters would be deliberated privately.
