

IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

March 12th, 2026– 1:30 p.m.

In attendance was Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner Lodge participated remotely. Commissioner Hardie called the meeting to order.
