

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

April 15th, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

In attendance was Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. Commissioner Dayn Hardie and Commissioner Edward Lodge participated remotely. Commissioner Hammond called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was the **ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDED AGENDA** for April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.
