

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

April 28th, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

In attendance was Commissioner Edward Lodge, Commissioner John R. Hammond, Jr. and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner Lodge called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was the **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING** on April 23rd, 2026. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes as written.

The next order of business was **CONSENT AGENDA:**

**2. Action Item: Seungjae Lee’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Idaho Power’s Tariff Advice for Administrative Modifications to Rule N, Special Arrangements for Substation Allowances and Transmission Vested Interest; Case No. IPC-TAE-26-02.**

**3. Action Item: Michael Ott’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Valiant Idaho Inc./TIC Utilities, LLC’s Application to Increase Its Rates and Charges for Water Service in the State of Idaho; Case No. VID-W-25-02.**

**4. Action Item: Kelsea E. Ross’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Idaho Power Company’s Application for Authority to Implement Power Cost Adjustment (“PCA”) Rates for Electric Service from June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027; Case No. IPC-E-26-10.**

**5. Action Item: Kevin Maxwell’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Intermountain Gas Company Tariff Advice No. INT-TAG-26-01 Revision to Rate Schedule FT (Franchise Fee/Tax Adjustment), Sheet No. 15; Case No. INT-TAG-26-01.**

Commissioner Hardie made a motion, under Idaho Code § 74-204, to amend the agenda, moving Action Items No. 4 from the CONSENT AGENDA to MATTERS IN PROGRESS, Action Item No. 4. Kelsea E. Ross’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Idaho Power Company’s Application for Authority to Implement Power Cost Adjustment (“PCA”) Rates for Electric Service from June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027; Case No. IPC-E-26-10. A vote was taken on the motion and it carried unanimously.

Commissioner Lodge made a motion to approve Staff’s recommendations for Items 2, 3, and 5 under the Consent Agenda. A vote was taken on the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The next order of business was **MATTERS IN PROGRESS:**

**4. Action Item: Kelsea E. Ross’s April 28, 2026, Decision Memorandum re: In the Matter of Idaho Power Company’s Application for Authority to Implement Power Cost Adjustment (“PCA”) Rates for Electric Service from June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027; Case No. IPC-E-26-10.**

Ms. Kelsea Ross presented the memorandum regarding Idaho Power Company’s application in which the Company requested approval of its annual PCA adjustment filing. Staff recommended processing the case under modified procedure with a public comment deadline of May 12, 2026, and a reply comment deadline

of May 19, 2026. During discussion, Commissioner Hardie noted the short comment window typical of expedited “rocket docket” cases but suggested extending the public comment deadline to May 19, 2026, while setting a shortened company reply deadline of May 21, 2026. Staff indicated no concerns with the revised schedule and reported no indication that the Company would be unable to meet the proposed dates.

With no further comments from staff or other Commissioners, Commissioner Hardie made a motion for the Commission to issue a Notice of Application and Notice of Modified Procedure establishing the revised May 19, 2026 public comment deadline and May 21, 2026 company reply deadline. A vote was taken on the motion, and it carried unanimously.

The last order of business was **FULLY SUBMITTED MATTERS:**

**6. Deliberation re: In the Matter of Avista Corporation’s Applications for a Determination of 2024 Electric and Natural Gas Energy Efficiency Expenses as Prudently Incurred; Case Nos. AVU-E-25-12 and AVU-G-25-09 [Jeffrey R. Loll, Attorney].**

**7. Deliberation re: In the Matter of Intermountain Gas Company’s Application for Authority to Revise Rate Schedule EE-GS – General Service Energy Efficiency Rebate Program; Case No. INT-G-25-07 [Jeffrey R. Loll, Attorney].**

**8. Deliberation re: In the Matter of Intermountain Gas Company’s Application for Authority to Revise Rate Schedule EE-RS – Residential Energy Efficiency Rebate Program; Case No. INT-G-26-02 [Kelsea E. Ross, Attorney].**
