

# IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

## MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

### SUBJECT TO APPROVAL

**May 26th, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.**

In attendance was Commissioner Edward Lodge, Commissioner Dayn Hardie, and Commissioner John R. Hammond. Commissioner Hammond called the meeting to order.

Kelsea Ross clarified that staff, and the company had requested the cancelation of comment deadlines as they would like to enter settlement negotiations. If no settlement is reached staff will request new comment deadlines.

Donn English added that the company's representatives will not be available to enter negotiations in time to meet the comment deadlines.

Commissioner Hammond made a motion to approve Staff's recommendations for Items 2 through 5 under the Consent Agenda. A vote was taken on the motion, and it carried unanimously.
