

IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

July 23, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

In attendance were Commissioner Edward Lodge, Commissioner John R. Hammond Jr. and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner Lodge called the meeting to order.
