

IDAHO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

MINUTES OF DECISION MEETING

August 4th, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

In attendance were Commissioner Edward Lodge and Commissioner Dayn Hardie. Commissioner John R. Hammond Jr. was absent. Commissioner Lodge called the meeting to order.
