MINUTE ENTRY

On May 1, 2008, Atlanta Power Company (Atlanta Power; Company) filed an Application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requesting a general rate increase in the Company's basic tariff rates for electric service together with a request for an emergency surcharge.

On June 27, 2008, the Commission in Order No. 30578 approved "an emergency temporary surcharge of 33.6% applied to all tariff rates (except the Schedule 4 "new customer connection charge") and meter testing charges (General Rules – Regulations and Rates ¶ 15 – Service and Limitations)." Atlanta Power Company was directed to file a surcharge tariff prior to implementation.

On June 30, 2008, Atlanta Power filed a proposed Schedule 5 Temporary Surcharge tariff sheet. The Commission has reviewed the Company's tariff filing and finds it to be in compliance with the Commission's Order No. 30578. The Commission by this Minute Entry and without further notice approves the submitted Schedule 5 Temporary Surcharge tariff for effective date July 1, 2008.
