A proposed reduction in the Company's current Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) surcharge rate is also requested. The net amount of actual increase varies by class of customer and usage.

On February 25, 2004, the Commission issued Notices of Application and Intervention Deadline in Case Nos. AVU-E-04-1 and AVU-G-04-1. Parties requesting and granted intervention were: Potlatch Corporation, Coeur Silver Valley, Inc. and Community Action Partnership Association of Idaho.
