On August 31, 2007, Avista Corporation ("Avista") filed an Application seeking authority to implement a one-year pilot program for the remote disconnection and reconnection of customers to its system. On December 4, 2007, the Commission deferred approval of the Company's pilot program and ordered that two public workshops be held in Lewiston and Coeur d'Alene, Idaho "to further refine and develop the details of the pilot program." Order No. 30471.
