As Idaho's largest state-based conservation organization, we have approximately 1,000 members who are residential customers of Avista. ICL's Sandpoint Idaho office is a small

commercial customer of Avista. ICL as an organization, and on behalf of our members how are Avista customers, have a direct and substantial interest in ensuring prudent capital investments and operational spending by Avista along with fair. just, and reasonable electric rates for customers. ICL brings a unique and valuable perspective to this proceeding by virtue of our focus on highlighting the full costs and future risks of spending on fossil fueled generation and our goal to craft electric rates the encourage the efficient use of electricity by consumers. By responding to Avista's requests for additional revenues and rate changes ICL's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in this proceeding.

3. ICL intends to fully participate in this matter as a party. The nature and quality of ICL's intervention in the proceeding is dependant upon the nature and effect of other evidence in this proceeding.
