On July 13, 2021, Avista Corporation ("Avista") and Stimson Lumber Company ("Stimson") filed a Joint Petition ("Application") seeking approval of Amendment No. 2 to their Power Purchase and Sale Agreement ("Agreement").

The Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") now sets deadlines for interested persons to comment on the Application and for the Company to reply.

#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that "Amendment No. 2 extends the term of the original Agreement through December 31, 2023, and updates the Agreement to apply the current published avoided cost rates to all power purchases by Avista under the Agreement during the period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023 . . ." Application at 1.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the "Agreement as amended by Amendment No. 1 was approved by the Commission in Order No. 34692 issued on June 15, 2020. The original Term of the Agreement was due to expire on December 31, 2021." *Id.* at 3.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that "the Amendment replaces Section 5.5 of the Agreement to extend the term as follows:

The term of the Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall continue through December 31, 2023, unless terminated earlier by the terms and conditions contained herein."

Id.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that Amendment No. 2 replaces Exhibit E to the Agreement to update the avoided cost rates that will apply during the Extension Period. Except as expressly amended, all other terms of the Agreement remain in full force and effect for the Extension Period." *Id.*

If written comments are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider them and, in its discretion, may set the same for formal hearing.

#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Company's Application be processed by Modified Procedure, Rule 201-204 (IDAPA 31.01.01.201-.204). Persons shall have twenty-eight (28) days from the service date on this Order to file written comments. The Company must file any reply comments thirty-five (35) days from the Service date on this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties should continue to comply with Order No. 35058, issued June 3, 2021. All pleadings should be filed with the Commission electronically and shall be deemed timely filed when received by the Commission Secretary. *See* Rule 14.02.

Service between parties should also be accomplished electronically. Voluminous discovery-related documents may be filed and served on CD-ROM or a USB flash drive.
