On February 13, 2026, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (“Company”) applied to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) requesting authority to increase its Schedule 91, “Energy Efficiency Rider Adjustment” rates, effective May 1, 2026 (“Application”).

On May 1, 2026, the Commission issued Order No. 37025, authorizing a 3.3% increase in overall billed rates. The Commission directed the Company to submit its updated Schedule 91 tariff in compliance with the rates and charges approved in Order No. 37025.

On May 1, 2026, the Company filed its updated Schedule 91 tariff reflecting the rates approved in Order No. 37025 (“Compliance Filing”). At the Commission’s Decision Meeting on May 19, 2026, Commission Staff presented a Decision Memorandum recommending the Commission accept the Company’s Compliance Filing, as filed, effective May 1, 2026.

COMMISSION FINDINGS AND DECISION

The Commission has jurisdiction over the Company’s Application and the issues in this case under Title 61 of the Idaho Code including, *Idaho Code* §§ 61-501, -502, and -503, and the Commission’s Rule of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.000, *et seq.* The Commission is empowered to investigate rates, charges, rules, regulations, practices, and contracts of all public utilities and to determine whether they are just, reasonable, preferential, discriminatory, or in violation of any provisions of law, and to fix the same by order. *Idaho Code* §§ 61-501, -502, and -503.


Having reviewed the record and the Company’s Compliance Filing, the Commission finds that the Company has complied with Order No. 37025 to update Schedule 91 tariff to reflect the rates approved in Order No. 37025.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the updated Schedule 91 contained in the Compliance Filing submitted on May 1, 2026, is approved, effective May 1, 2026.

THIS IS A FINAL ORDER. Any person interested in this Order may petition for reconsideration within 21 days of the service date upon this Order regarding any matter decided in this Order. Within seven days after any person has petitioned for reconsideration, any other person may cross-petition for reconsideration. *Idaho Code* § 61-626.
