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On February 2, 2024, Riverside Electric Company, Limited (“Riverside”) and Farmers Electric Company (“Farmers”) filed an application with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) for approval of a Service Territory Agreement (“Agreement”) between Riverside and Farmers.

On June 5, 2024, the Commission issued a Final Order approving the Service Territory Agreement and requiring the parties to submit an executed Agreement to the Commission. Order No. 36211. On June 27, 2024, Riverside submitted an executed Agreement.

**COMMISSION FINDINGS AND DECISION**


Having reviewed the Application, the record, and the submitted executed Agreement, the Commission finds that the submitted executed Agreement conforms with the provisions of Order No. 36211.


**ORDER**
