COMES NOW the NW Energy Coalition (NVEC) and hereby requests leave to intervene in the above captioned matter pursuant to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-073. As discussed below, NVEC has direct and substantial interests in these proceedings, and therefore should be granted intervention.

This Petition is filed well after the intervention deadline of November 30, 2018. NVEC is a party to docket IPC-E-18-16 regarding Idaho Power’s fixed costs that is proceeding on a parallel track and timeline. As these dockets have progressed, it has become apparent that some issues and information overlap between the dockets. NVEC seeks late intervention here to avoid any issues with confidential information that may overlap between the dockets. NVEC will abide by the established schedule and process the parties have adopted in this docket. NVEC will not broaden the issues, delay the proceeding, or otherwise prejudice any other interest in this docket.


