Comment: On January 15, 2019 I put into production a 10Kw solar system at my house (using net metering) so I have some 'skin in the game'. I am actually planning on adding another 10Kw later this year to my current setup. I just read the article in the Times News (Idaho Power files new case to study net metering). I think it is wrong for Idaho Power to suggest net generating customers are getting credited for things Idaho Power is paying for such as customer service. What is customer service? Is it the power poles and lines or their website? Those would exist regardless of whether I generate my own electricity or not. I strongly advise PUC to not allow Idaho Power to change the rates in which they pay for customer generation electricity. That is what this is all about. I also strongly advice PUC to not let Idaho Power close their net metering program. It is a major benefit of living in Southern Idaho that I can setup my own solar power system to be self sufficient.

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
