Comment: "As an Idaho Power customer with on-site generation(solar panels) I strongly object to Idaho Power's appeal to the PUC's decision on Case IPC-E-18-15. In their continued attempts to use the PUC to circumvent the federal law requiring Idaho Power to "purchase power" from customers with on-site generation, the company in this appeal again attempts to unfairly limit its customers. First, those of us with net metering have and will not receive any compensation from Idaho for the power we generate. The over 200 people who attended your first hearing, represented 100's of megawatts of energy that Idaho Power did not pay for. Nor did Idaho Power pay for the solar systems that generated that power. Second we are not expecting Idaho Power to pays us for the solar systems we have installed, unlike the power plants the company and you have allowed them to bills the customer base for. Thirdly, you instructed Idaho Power to do a study of the impact our solar systems have on its system. Over a"
