COMES NOW, the Idaho Conservation League, Vote Solar, NW Energy Coalition, Idaho Sierra Club, and the City of Boise, (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties"), pursuant to Rules of Procedure of the Idaho Public Utility Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.057.03 with the following Answer to Idaho Power Company's ("Idaho Power") Motion to Accept Fixed Cost Report filed on September 30, 2019.

As parties to this docket, we have engaged in several meetings over the past nine months in a collaborative effort to define "a comprehensive customer fixed-cost analysis to determine the proper methodology and 'spread' of fixed costs as they relate to the Company's customer." *Order No. 34190* (citing Petition at 2; citing *Order No. 34046* at 23.) Parties attempted to reach a consensus on how to do the study and the content that would be contained therein.

Unfortunately, Idaho Power's report to the Commission is narrowly focused on their preferred policy position and addresses a small set of rate design options that prioritize utility revenue recovery over other objectives. The Parties respectfully request that the Commission delay any decision regarding the Company's Motion to Accept Fixed Cost Report until after a comment

period of not less than ninety days. We look forward to providing the Commission with more detailed comments at that time.
