Therefore, Russell Schiermeier claims a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding in that terms and conditions for the continued and potential operation of his net metering operations may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. 3. This Intervenor intends to participate herein as a party, and if necessary, to introduce evidence, cross-examine witnesses, call and examine witnesses, and be heard in argument. The nature and quality of evidence which this Intervenor will introduce is dependent upon the nature and effect of other evidence in this proceeding.

A significant initial issue is to provide for a grandfathering process for existing net metering customers and to specifically delineate a date, going forward, at which new net metering projects will be subject to the outcome of this proceeding.
