I understand the complexities of integrating wind energy into the grid due to its unpredictable generation. Solar should be easier to integrate, as its output is much more predictable, and the seasonality of production better matches seasonality demand (summer when irrigation pumps and air conditioner compressors are running). Load shifting to better match grid production could be accomplished with more aggressive time of day energy rate programs and the evolving "smart appliances" as well as electric cars that can be programmed accordingly. Idaho Power, to their credit, has an optional time of day rate schedule for residential as well as their "AC cool credit" program to help with load management. The grid is going to change as micro generation becomes a bigger reality. Please ensure Idaho Power embraces these changes with fair treatment to their customers who wish to generate with solar.
