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The Idaho Hydroelectric Power Producers Trust, an Idaho Trust, d/b/a IdaHydro (“IdaHydro”) petitioned to intervene in this case on December 10, 2021. The Industrial Customers of Idaho Power (“ICIP”) petitioned to intervene in this case on December 17, 2021, and the Idaho Conservation League (“ICL”) petitioned to intervene in this case on December 21, 2021. All petitions were made pursuant to Rules of Procedure 71 through 75 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and should be granted.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by IdaHydro is hereby granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by ICIP is hereby granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by ICL is hereby granted.

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


