Idaho Hydroelectric Power Producers Trust, an Idaho Trust, d/b/a IdaHydro (“IdaHydro”) petitioned to intervene in this case on July 13, 2022. Idaho Irrigation Pumpers Association, Inc. (“IIPA”) petitioned to intervene in this case on July 15, 2022. All petitions were made pursuant to Rules of Procedure 71-75 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

FINDINGS OF FACT

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 of the Commission’s Rules of Procedure and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petitions to Intervene filed by CEO, IdaHydro and IIPA are granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties comply with all rules of the Commission including Rules of Procedure 71-75, and 222-223 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075, .222-.223.

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


