To the Idaho PUC,

I am writing this letter with the understanding Idaho Power once again is trying to change the Net metering rates for those that have chosen to go solar. I understand their study is trying to cut the net metering credits in half, based on their claims of all these costs they incur. I would have to disagree with Idaho Powers premise they have all these infrastructure costs to incur for those that choose to go solar.

My question is what infrastructure costs? The people choosing to go solar are the ones incurring these infrastructure costs, not Idaho Power. If anything, Idaho Power is benefitting by having more people in the valley switch to solar. Idaho Power is getting access to other power producing sources, while at the same time not having any maintenance costs associated with this power generation source. If anything, Idaho Power is probably making money by selling this basically free produced power on the open market. If Idaho Power is losing money on this setup, they have some poor financial people working for them.
