

Therefore, the Company believed “it would be useful to work with Staff in an effort to reach alignment on the contract amendments and related issues [in both cases] but has not yet been able to arrange this meeting.” *Id.* at 3. The Company stated it was seeking, in a parallel motion, Commission authorization to extend the compliance filing in Case No. IPC-E-22-28 to March 31, 2023. *Id.*¹

Thus, the Company requested Commission authorization to extend the Company reply comment deadline to March 31, 2023, in this case.

COMMISSION DECISION

For the reasons discussed in the Company’s Motion and on the record at the Decision Meeting, we find extending the Company reply comment deadline in this case to March 31, 2023, to be fair and reasonable.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Company’s Motion is granted. The Company shall have until March 31, 2023, to file reply comments in this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties comply with Order No. 35375, issued April 21, 2022. Generally, all pleadings should be filed with the Commission electronically and will be deemed timely filed when received by the Commission Secretary. *See* Rule 14.02. Service between parties should continue to be accomplished electronically when possible. However, voluminous discovery-related documents may be filed and served on CD-ROM or a USB flash drive.




