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The United States Department of Energy, on behalf of itself and other federal executive agencies (together, the “Federal Executive Agencies” or “FEA”) petitioned to intervene in this case on July 13, 2023, and the NW Energy Coalition (“NWEC”) petitioned to intervene in this case on July 14, 2023. Both petitions were filed pursuant to Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 and should be granted.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by FEA is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by NWEC is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties comply with all rules of the Commission including Rules 71-75, and 222-223, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075, .222-.223.


