The Idaho Hydroelectric Power Producers Trust, and Idaho Trust, d/b/a IdaHydro (“IdaHydro”) petitioned to intervene in this case on May 17, 2023, and Clean Energy Opportunities for Idaho (“CEO”) petitioned to intervene in this case on May 18, 2023. Both petitions were filed pursuant to Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

FINDINGS OF FACT

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by IdaHydro is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by CEO is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties comply with all rules of the Commission including Rules 71-75, and 222-223, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075, .222-.223.


