On April 3, 2024, Idaho Power Company ("Company") filed an application ("Application") with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") requesting an order granting the Company a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to acquire new dispatchable energy storage with 150 megawatts of operating capacity.

On April 23, 2024, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 36152. The Commission granted intervention to Micron Technology, Inc. and Clean Energy Opportunities for Idaho.

#### NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

Persons who would like a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments and explain why written comments alone are insufficient. **Persons interested in filing written comments must do so by August 28, 2024.** Comments must be filed through the Commission's website or by e-mail unless computer access is unavailable. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties comply with Order No. 35375, issued April 21, 2022. Generally, all pleadings should be filed with the Commission electronically and will be deemed timely filed when received by the Commission Secretary. *See* Rule 14.02. Service between parties should continue to be accomplished electronically when possible. However, voluminous discovery-related documents may be filed and served on CD-ROM or a USB flash drive.
