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The city of Boise City (“Boise City”) petitioned to intervene in this case on May 22, 2024, and Micron Technology, Inc. (“Micron”) petitioned to intervene in this case on May 24, 2024. These petitions were filed pursuant to Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

We find that no party opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule 74 and should be granted.




