On July 1, 2024, Idaho Power Company ("Company") filed an application ("Application") with the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") requesting an order approving the Second Amendment ("Second Amendment") to the Energy Sales Agreement ("ESA") between the Company and North Gooding Main Hydro LLC ("Seller") for electric energy generated by the Seller's North Gooding Main Hydro Project ("Facility" or "Project"), which is a PURPA Qualifying Facility ("QF").
