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IN THE MATTER OF IDAHO POWER COMPANY'S ANNUAL COMPLIANCE FILING TO UPDATE THE SUBSTATION ALLOWANCE AMOUNT UNDER SCHEDULE 19, LARGE POWER SERVICE CASE NO. IPC-E-25-01 NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE ORDER NO. 36491

On December 20, 2024, Idaho Power Company ("Company") submitted Tariff Advice No. IPC-TAE-24-06. The Company indicated that this annual compliance filing is to update the Substation Allowance amount contained in Schedule 19, as required by Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Order Nos. 32893 and 32914.

On January 27, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Application, Notice of Suspension of Proposed Effective Date, and Notice of Intervention Deadline. No parties intervened.

## NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE

Persons who would like a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments and explain why written comments alone are insufficient. **Persons interested in filing written comments must do so by March 13, 2025.** Comments must be filed through the Commission's website or by e-mail unless computer access is unavailable. Click the "Case Comment Form" and complete the form using the case number as it appears on the front of this document.
