On May 30, 2025, Idaho Power Company ("Company") applied to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") requesting authority to increase its rates and charges for electric service to its customers in the State of Idaho and for associated regulatory accounting treatment. The Company requested a July 1, 2025, effective date.

On June 13, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Application, Notice of Suspension of Proposed Effective Date, and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 36638. The Commission granted intervention to: Clean Energy Opportunities for Idaho; Idaho Irrigation Pumpers Association, Inc.; the city of Boise City; the Federal Executive Agencies; the Industrial Customers of Idaho Power; Micron Technologies, Inc.; the Idaho Hydroelectric Power Producers Trust; Gannon, et al., *pro se*; the Kroger Co.; and the Northwest Energy Coalition. Order Nos. 36557, 36635, 36665, 36666, 36685, 36690, and 36691. On July 30, 2025, the Commission issued a Notice of Parties.
