On December 3, 2019, Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”), a division of PacifiCorp, applied to the Commission for approval of the 2020 PacifiCorp Inter-Jurisdictional Allocation Protocol (“2020 Protocol”). PacifiCorp provides electric service in six states. PacifiCorp operates as Rocky Mountain Power in Idaho, Utah, and Wyoming, and as Pacific Power in Oregon, Washington, and California. The Company requests the Commission approve its use of the 2020 Protocol with an effective date of January 1, 2020.

On January 8, 2020, the Commission issued a Notice of the Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 34525. PacifiCorp Idaho Industrial Customers, Idaho Conservation League, and Monsanto Company then intervened as parties. *See* Order Nos. 34555 and 34557.

The Commission now issues this Notice of Modified Procedure setting comment and reply deadlines.

**NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE**

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter and will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Idaho Public Utilities Commission’s Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201-.204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that any person desiring to state a position on the Company’s Application must file a written comment in support or opposition with the Commission **by April 7, 2020**. The comment must contain a statement of reasons supporting the comment. Persons desiring a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments.
