P4 Production, L.L.C., an affiliate of Bayer Corporation (“Bayer”) petitioned to intervene in this case on October 31, 2022, and the Idaho Irrigation Pumpers Association, Inc. (“IIPA”) petitioned to intervene in this case on November 3, 2022. Both petitions were filed pursuant to Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

FINDINGS OF FACT

We find that no party timely opposed these Petitions to Intervene.

We further find that based on the pleadings and other documents filed in this case, intervention by these parties would serve the purposes of intervention as described by Rule of Procedure 74 and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Bayer’s Petition to Intervene is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the IIPA’s Petition to Intervene is granted.


