Without these products I would have no need for the facilities and lines. I believe that most customers would have this same understanding. However, with the charge of many home owners going to solan as wind, it may be necessary to establish a service type schedule to cover Rocky mountan power cost for these customers.

Based on my conclusions sited above, I recommend that Rocky mountain power rate request be placed on hold until a more equitable rate schedule is augilable.
