On June 29, 2023, Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, ("Company") applied to the Idaho Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") requesting the Commission complete the study review phase of the costs and benefits for on-site customer generation ("Application"). Commission Order No. 34753 defined the scope of the Company's on-site customer generation study ("Study"). The Company submitted its Study and supplemental materials concurrently with its Application and requested a timeline for intervention and public review. The Company further asked that the case be processed by modified procedure and that the Commission enter a finding that the Study's scope satisfied Order No. 34753.

On July 31, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 35870. The Idaho Irrigation Pumpers Association was the only party to intervene.
