On July 19, 2017, Avista announced that it had entered into a merger agreement with Hydro One ("Applicants"). On September 14, 2017, the Applicants filed a joint application for approval of the merger. Approval of the Application would result in Avista becoming a wholly owned subsidiary of a Hydro One holding company. The Applicants have requested approval by August 14, 2018, and have made the same request in other state jurisdictions.

On October 5, 2017, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and ordered an intervention deadline of October 26, 2017. Order No. 33903. Idaho Forest Group, Clearwater Paper, Idaho Conservation League (ICL), the Community Action Partnership Association of Idaho (CAPAI), and the Washington and Northern Idaho District Council of Laborers (WNIDCL) intervened as parties.

With this Order, we approve the proposed timeline, and schedule a technical hearing for the parties to testify before the Commission. The Commission will schedule public informational workshops, and a public hearing by separate Order at a later date.
