In addition to statements provided during the public hearing in Sandpoint, ID on June 13, 2018 primarily focused on Hydro One's financial stability based on its 4Q2017 public financial reporting. I'd like to add how the leadership instability at Hydro One further undermines its proposed acquisition of Avista Corp.

Given that the Hydro One CEO was forced to resign by Canadian parliamentary pressures and the entire Board of Directors stepped down, it is not in the interest of Avista rate payers to be subjected to such instabilities.
