The Idaho Conservation League (“ICL”) and the NW Energy Coalition (“NVEC”) jointly petitioned to intervene in this case on March 14, 2023. The petition was filed pursuant to Idaho Public Utilities Commission Rules of Procedure 71-75, IDAPA 31.01.01.071-.075.

FINDINGS OF FACT

We find that no party timely opposed this Petition to Intervene.




