On February 21, 2025, Idaho Forest Group LLC (“IFG”) moved the Idaho Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), under Commission Rule of Procedure 43.03<sup>1</sup> and Idaho Bar Commission Rule (“IBCR”) 227, for an Order approving the limited admission, pro hac vice, of Eden A. Fauré in this case. The Motion was signed and attested to by local counsel Jennifer S. Palmer (Idaho State Bar License No. 11136).

In the Motion, Ms. Fauré certifies that she is an active member in good standing with the bar of Minnesota and that she maintains the regular practice of law in Minnesota. She further declares that she is not an Idaho resident or licensed to practice law in Idaho.

Ms. Fauré and Ms. Palmer certify that a copy of the Motion has been served on all other parties to this case, and that a copy of the Motion, accompanied by a \$325 fee and certificate of good standing, have been submitted to the Idaho State Bar. Ms. Palmer acknowledges that her attendance shall be required at all Commission proceedings in which Ms. Fauré appears, unless specifically excused by the Commission.

**COMMISSION FINDINGS**

The Commission has reviewed and considered the Motion and applicable rules, including IBCR 227 and Commission Rules of Procedure 19 and 43.03, IDAPA 31.01.01.019 and 043.03. Based on the filings of record and certified representations of Ms. Fauré and Ms. Palmer, we find that reasonable grounds have been demonstrated to justify the granting of limited admission of Ms. Fauré as legal counsel for IFG. We further find good reason to excuse the appearance of Ms. Palmer in further proceedings in this docket unless needed by Ms. Fauré.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attendance of Jennifer S. Palmer is excused from all further proceedings in Case Nos. AVU-E-25-01 and AVU-G-25-01 unless needed by Eden A. Fauré.


