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On January 12, 2021, Intermountain Gas Company (“Company”) applied to the Commission requesting authority to decrease its depreciation and amortization rates from a combined 2.97%<sup>1</sup> to 2.55%.

On February 8, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Application and Notice of Intervention Deadline. Order No. 34914. No one petitioned to intervene.

Now, the Commission issues this Notice of Modified Procedure establishing deadlines for interested persons to comment on the Application and for the Company to reply.

**NOTICE OF MODIFIED PROCEDURE**

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Commission has determined that the public interest may not require a formal hearing in this matter, and that it will proceed under Modified Procedure pursuant to Rules 201 through 204 of the Commission's Rules of Procedure, IDAPA 31.01.01.201 through .204. The Commission notes that Modified Procedure and written comments have proven to be an effective means for obtaining public input and participation.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that persons desiring to state a position on the Company’s Application may file a written comment explaining why the person supports or opposes the Application. Persons who would like a hearing must specifically request a hearing in their written comments. **Persons shall have until June 8, 2021 to file written comments.** Comments must be filed through the Commission’s website or by e-mail unless computer access is unavailable. To comment electronically, please access the Commission’s home page at [www.puc.idaho.gov](http://www.puc.idaho.gov). Click the “Case Comment Form” and complete the form using the case number as it appears on the front of this document. **YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED** that if no written comments or protests are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider this matter on its merits and enter its order without a formal hearing. If written comments are received within the time limit set, the Commission will consider them and, in its discretion, may set the same for a formal hearing.

**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this case be processed by Modified Procedure. Interested persons must file written comments by June 8, 2021. The Company must file any reply comments by June 22, 2021.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that parties should continue to comply with Order No. 34781, issued September 17, 2020. All pleadings should be filed with the Commission electronically and shall be deemed timely filed when received by the Commission Secretary. *See* Rule 14.02. Service between parties should also be accomplished electronically. Voluminous discovery-related documents may be filed and served on CD-ROM or a USB flash drive.


